

The Performers and Process

Mixed-Ability Cast

Trained in sensory engagement, ensuring a sensitive and inclusive performance.

Parental Rehearsals

Parents/guardians attend two rehearsals to customize the show for their child. Date to be discussed with the production team.

Show Details and Schedule

The show takes place at **Studio A, Spazju Kreattiv**, Valletta.

-Choose **one date and time** to book via ziguajg.org/techrail – participants attend **only at their booked time** to avoid waiting.

-The show is **ticketed at €5 per child and €8 per adult**. Each child may be Accompanied by up to 2 familiar adults.

- An info booklet will be provided beforehand to help prepare participants on the spectrum for what to expect.
